Ramon y Cajal Spanish Program: This program is open to scientists all over the world that want to develop his/her career in spanish scientific and academic institutions. The candidates should apply to a special nation-wide spanish call "Ramon y Cajal" Program open until January 16 th, 2018. This is a competitive call and the successfull candidates will be selected by a national Committee of prestigious researchers in their field. Only those candidates that are selected by this Committee can get the position in our Group of Research in Salamanca.

Application procedure: The electronic application form (solicitud) and regulations of this call can be found in the <u>webpage of the Ministerio de Economia de España</u>. The candidate should write a Summary of his/her research career and the main research line that she/he has carried out as well as enter the CV online with a complete list of publications.

The salary will be **33,720 euros** and an additional Grant of **40,000 euros for scientific research.** During the 5 year contract the candidate can apply for spanish or international projects as PI. The successfull candidate should carry out research in the fields mentioned above and a limited teaching can apply.

Requirements: The applicants must hold a PhD between January 1st, 2007 and December 31st, 2014. English required.
