The work consists of carrying out statistical and integrative data analyses related to the Project. The data consist of chemical and biological measurements carried out from samples collected during field studies by the project partners in different parts of the Baltic Sea in 2023-2025. The integrative data analysis aims at assessing the ecological status of the study sites and examining the linkages between chemical pollution, health of biota and biodiversity. The work includes also interpretation of the results and their timely delivery to the Client. The work will be carried out in the first half of 2026. The supervisor of the work from the Client's part is Dr. Kari Lehtonen and the main researcher from the DiSVA-UNIVPM part is Francesco Regoli.
